You may qualify for reduced Fee for Registration. Also required is your car's date of inspection. It is the responsibility of each tenant to ensure that the office has the most up to date information.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

You may qualify for Reduced Registration fee. Eligible applicants, regardless of age, must be retired and receiving Social Security, SSI payments, retirement benefits or other pensions and annuities. The total income from all sources named above must not exceed \$19,200. Retired persons may apply for the \$10 processing fee at the time of registration renewal.

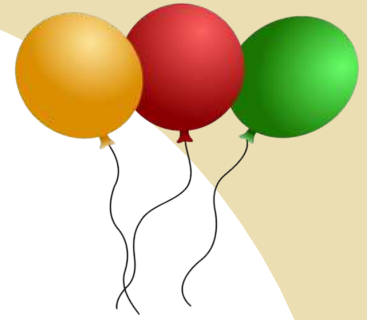

Per Capita Tax Exemption Applications

Age Exemption:

Under age 18 or over age 65 on July 1 of the subject tax year.

(Provide copy of birth certificate or valid ID)

Income Exemption:

May not exceed \$10,000 from all sources, which includes (but is not limited to): combined income from wages, salary, fees, pensions, Social Security, public assistance, commissions, gross business income, rents, royalties, dividends, alimony or separate maintenance payments, annuities, income from estates or trusts, deferred compensation. Provide documentation.

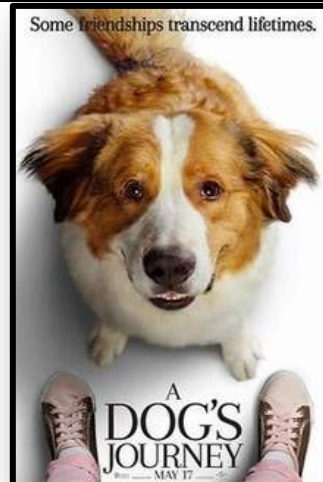

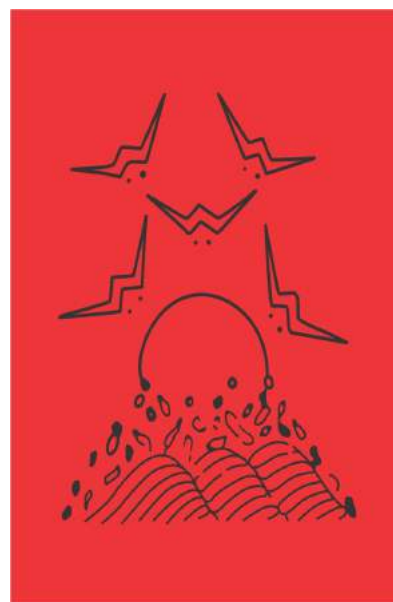

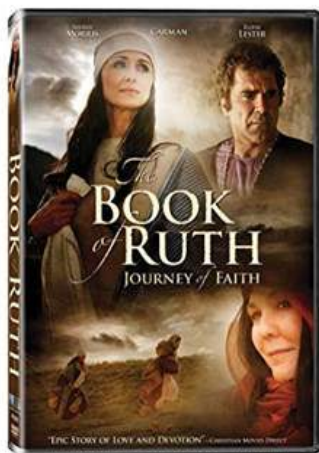
