



A father brings up his baby girl as a single dad after the unexpected death of his wife who died a day after their daughter's birth.


Movie 3: The Terminal

Recycling Tips

RULE #3: CLEAN, EMPTY, AND DRY



Should be clean enough to use

Be sure to completely rinse your recyclables. Also, many products will tell you to remove the label or cap if need-be.

Recycling Facts

- -1 ton of recycled cardboard saves 9 cubic yards of landfill space.
- -It takes 88% more energy to make new plastic than it does to recycle plastic!
- -Americans throw out 25 billion styrofoam coffee cups a year... which will never decompose.
 - -Aluminum and glass can be recycled endlessly without loss of quality.
 - -Recycling 1 ton of paper saves 7,000 gallons of water.

What can be Recycled here at Lutheran Manor?

- -Plastics 1-7 that are smaller than 5 gallons (remove caps, but still recycle them)
- -Clear and colored glass containers
- -Aluminum, steel, tin and aerosol cans
 - -Corrugated cardboard and brown paper bags
- -Mixed office paper, phone books, magazines, newspaper
