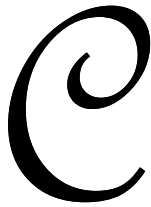
Thanks to all who helped make this year's Spring Bazaar a success. I know it was a lot of work but it was all worth it.

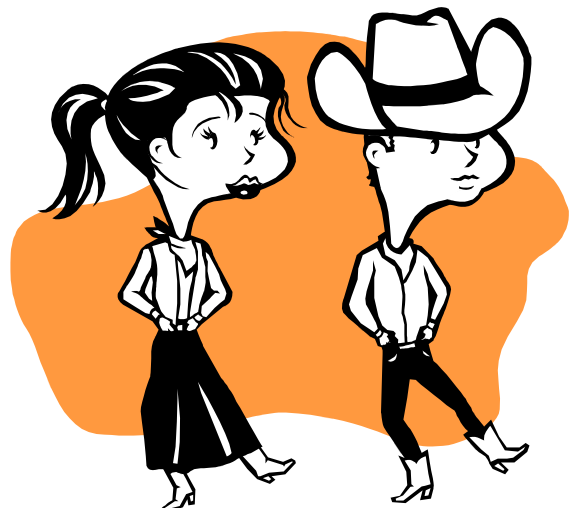

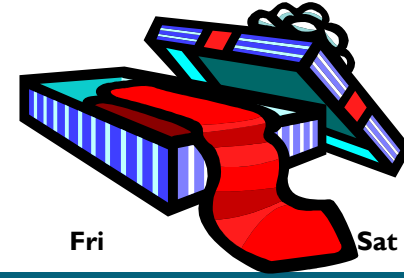
